### MAST OPERATION

1. Lift the LED head fully upwards then slide the mast down to lock into the mount.
2. Pull the lever on the black locking clamp, lift the head upwards to the desired height and push the lever back into place.
3. To collapse the mast, reverse the procedure.

### LIGHT OPERATION

1. Press the power switch (located on the backside of the light head) once for high mode.
2. Press again for low mode.
3. Press again to turn off.

**FLASHING MODE:** From the Off position, press and hold the switch for 6 seconds for flashing high mode. Press again for flashing low mode. Press again for Off.
